All families are encouraged to apply before July 1<sup>st</sup>. Tuition assistance is limited and awarded on a first come first serve basis. The majority of the available assistance is awarded by July for the school year starting in August. Families applying after July 1<sup>st</sup> are more likely to receive lesser awards (if any) due to limited funding.
