STEPS ON HOW YOU CAN APPLY!

Tuition assistance will only be offered to CFCA students who have completed the enrollment or reenrollment process and paid the enrollment deposit for the school year in which they are applying for tuition assistance. Assistance is limited and awarded on a first come first serve basis.

HOW TO APPLY:

- Go to <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3D4X5>
- Follow the on screen instructions at the bottom of the page under the heading:
(Simple Steps to Enroll in a Payment Plan or Apply for Financial Aid)

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Payment of the \$30.00 nonrefundable application fee. (If you do not pay online it does delay the process)
- Copies of your most recent IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040-EZ U.S. Individual Income Tax Return.
If applicant and co-applicant file separately, you will need both tax returns for the same tax year.
- Copies of all previous year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both the applicant and co-applicant.
NOTE: If you are applying before you have received all the previous year W-2 Wage and Tax Statements, please submit them as soon as they become available.
- Copies of all supporting tax schedules if you have income from any of the following:
 - Business – (Form 1040 Line 12) Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Farm – (Form 1040 Line 18) Schedule F and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Rental Property – (Form 1040 Line 17) Schedule E (page 1)
 - S-Corporation – (Form 1040 Line 17) Schedule E (page 2), Form 1120S (4 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 - Partnership – (Form 1040 Line 17) Schedule E (page 2), Form 1065 (5 pages), Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
 - Estates and Trusts – (Form 1040 Line 17) Schedule E (page 2), Form 1041 and Schedule K-1

IMPORTANT: If you file a tax return but do not have W-2 wages because you are self-employed, you will be required to submit a copy of your previous year Federal Form 1040 Tax Return.

- Copies of all supporting documentation for household Non-Taxable Income such as: Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

* Completed Applications on or before May 1st will have a reply by June 1st.

* Completed Applications on or before June 1st will have a reply by July 1st.

* Completed Applications on or before July 1st will have a reply by August 1st.

* Completed Applications on or before August 1st will have a reply by September 1st.

* Completed Applications after August 1st will take up to 30 days for a reply.
