## GUIDELINES

To be eligible to receive tuition assistance you must have completed the online evaluation thru FACTS management at: [www.factsmgmt.com](http://www.factsmgmt.com).

All families are encouraged to apply before July 1st. Tuition assistance is limited and awarded on a first come first serve basis. The majority of the available assistance is awarded by July for the school year starting in August. Families applying after July 1st are more likely to receive lesser awards (if any) due to limited funding.
