While we know it is very necessary for students to have time to enjoy family, fun, and growth in many aspects during the summer, CFCA believes that our students can continue to keep their minds fresh and focused over the summer to encourage retaining knowledge gained during the school year.

This year, we are taking a different approach to summer work. All students in Grades 6-12 will have an IXL account (many already do) and will use their account to complete a Summer Boost program in both Math and ELA. For ELA, students will just need to complete the appropriate grade level plan. For Math, students will complete the plan for the class they will be entering. For example, if your student has completed Algebra I, they will follow the Geometry plan to prepare them for Geometry.

IXL recommends that students complete one skill each day for 20 days for each plan they are completing. Please keep this in mind as you have your student work on their summer assignments.
